It's not just about their work, it's about the collective class as work as well, which was really nice to see.

Because our child is deaf, we do tend to not always go to experiences like that, don't we? Yeah. When the actors came into school and it was obvious that Tyler was able to hear everything really well and they were very adaptable to his needs, it definitely means that we will try some of these things, definitely and go to theatre would be great.
